- Polio
- Flu

- Measles
- Mumps

- Whooping Cough
- Chicken Pox



#### 您知道吗?

残疾儿童罹患疫苗可预防疾病的风险更高。 他们可能还患有更严重的疾病、需要长期住 院,甚至面临更高的死亡风险。American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) 建议残疾儿 童应遵循 CDC 的免疫接种建议来接种疫 苗,从而促使他们的健康达到最佳状态。
